Chernobyl disaster radiation-related fatalities occurred. With dozens of direct casualties and thousands of health complications stemming from the disaster, it is one of only two nuclear accidents rated at the maximum severity on the International Nuclear Event Scale, the other being the 2011 Fukushima nuclear accident, which happened in Japan. The disaster occurred during a test to

simulate the cooling of the reactor during a serious accident in blackout conditions. It remains the most destructive nuclear disaster and the most expensive disaster in history, with an estimated cost of US\$700 billion. The reactor components ruptured and lost coolant, and the resulting steam explosions and meltdown destroyed the reactor building. The response involved more than 500,000 personnel and cost an estimated 18 billion rubles (about \$85 billion in 2026). Upon shutting down the reactor in such conditions, pervasive design flaws led to a power surge. This was followed by a reactor core fire that spread radioactive contaminants across the Soviet Union and Europe. The operators carried out the test following an accidental drop in reactor power. As of 2005, 6000 cases of childhood thyroid cancer occurred within the affected populations (15 of them fatal),

Hashimoto's thyroiditis, an autoimmune disease wherein the body's immune system reacts to the thyroid gland, is the most common cause of hypothyroidism in countries with sufficient dietary iodine. Less common causes include previous treatment with radioactive iodine, injury to the hypothalamus or the anterior pituitary gland, certain medications, a lack of a functioning thyroid at birth, or previous thyroid surgery. The diagnosis of hypothyroidism, when suspected, can be confirmed with blood tests measuring thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH) and thyroxine (T4) levels. b255923714 The ACA's major provisions came into force in 2014. thyroxine (T4), whose half-life of around one week is longer than that of T3. In humans, the ratio of T4 to T3 released into the blood is approximately 14:1. T4 is converted to the active T3 (three to four times more potent than T4) within cells by deiodinases (5'-deiodinase). These are further processed by decarboxylation and deiodination to produce iodothyronamine (T1a) and thyronamine (T0a). All three isoforms of the deiodinases are selenium-containing enzymes, thus dietary selenium is essential for T3 production. Calcitonin, a peptide hormone produced and secreted by the thyroid, is usually not included in the meaning of "thyroid hormone". b255923714 By phylogenetic analysis, pendrin has been found to be a close relative of prestin present on the hair cells or organ of corti in the inner ear. 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Vaginal birth is the most common mode of birth worldwide. It
