In the United States, approximately 51% of the six million annual pregnancies are unintended. A majority of the women affected by an unintended pregnancy are either 20–24 in age, poor or of low income, or are a member of a minority group. Unintended pregnancy rates are generally higher in the South and Southwest regions of the United States, in densely populated areas. A lack of family planning, limited access to birth control, or inconsistent use of birth control, are some of the contributing factors to unintended pregnancy. Other factors that lead to unintended pregnancy are birth control or contraception failure, rape or incest, unprotected sex, or unsuccessful vasectomy or tubal ligation.

Miscarriage Miscarriage before six weeks of gestation is defined as biochemical loss by ESHRE. Spontaneous fetal termination after 20 weeks of gestation is known as a stillbirth. problems, and drug or alcohol use. The term miscarriage is sometimes used to refer to all forms of pregnancy loss and pregnancy with abortive outcomes before 20 weeks of gestation. About 80% of miscarriages occur in the first 12 weeks of pregnancy (the first trimester). Once ultrasound or histological evidence shows that a pregnancy has existed, the term used is clinical miscarriage, which can be "early" (before 12 weeks) or "late" (between 12 and 21 weeks). Many of the early signs of pregnancy will be similar to symptoms that come right before a period, and it can be hard to tell the difference. Common causes of early pregnancy bleeding include miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, and subchorionic hematomas. Other causes include implantation bleeding, gestational trophoblastic disease, cervical changes, or infections. Assessment of first trimester bleeding includes history and physical exam (including speculum examination), imaging using ultrasound, and lab work such as beta-hCG and ABO/Rh blood tests. == Types of reproduction and pregnancy == Counselors may provide information on what services are available to help women decide how to handle their pregnancy. Severe complications of pregnancy, childbirth, and the puerperium are present in 1.6% of mothers in the US, and in 1.5% of mothers in Canada. In the immediate postpartum period (puerperium), 87% to 94% of women report at least one health problem. Long-term health problems (persisting after six months postpartum) are reported by 31% of women. Treatment depends on the underlying cause. Emergent management is indicated for patients with significant blood loss or hemodynamic instability. Anti-D immune globulin is usually recommended in those who are Rh-negative. Early pregnancy loss can be treated with expectant management, medication, or surgical intervention. Ectopic pregnancy can be treated with medication or surgical management, although emergent intervention is...
