

Can Gasoline Go Bad

Whether a higher octane fuel improves or impairs an engine's performance depends on the design of the engine. In broad terms, fuels with a higher octane rating are used in higher-compression gasoline engines, which may yield higher power for these engines. The added power in such cases comes from the way the engine is designed to compress the air/fuel mixture, and not directly from the rating of the gasoline. 801f6e9ac1

Octane rating Octane rating does not relate directly to the power output or the energy content of the fuel per unit mass or volume, but simply indicates the resistance to auto-ignition under pressure without a spark. The higher the octane number, the more compression the fuel can withstand before auto-igniting. Ethanol energy density can be compared with gasoline in heat-of-combustion tables. The term refers to the equivalent ratio of a blend of iso-octane and heptane that produces the same knocking characteristics.
