Common Access Card Defense personnel that use the CAC include the Selected Reserve and National Guard, United States Department of Defense (DoD) civilian employees, United States Coast Guard (USCG) civilian employees and eligible DoD and USCG contractor personnel. In combination with a personal identification number, a CAC satisfies the requirement for two-factor authentication: something the user knows combined with something the user has. The common access card, also commonly referred to as the CAC, is the standard identification for active duty United States defense personnel. It also serves as an identification card under the Geneva Conventions (especially the Third Geneva Convention). The card itself is a smart card about the size of a credit card. The CAC also satisfies the requirements for digital signature and data encryption technologies: authentication, integrity and non-repudiation. It is also the principal card used to enable physical access to buildings and controlled spaces, and it provides access to defense computer networks and systems.
