Injection (medicine) There are many types of injection, which are generally named after the body tissue the injection is administered into. Medical professionals are trained to give IM injections, but people An injection (often and usually referred to as a "shot" in US English, a "jab" in UK English, or a "jag" in Scottish English and Scots) is the act of administering a liquid, especially a drug, into a person's body using a needle (usually a hypodermic needle) and a syringe. An injection is considered a form of parenteral drug administration; it does not involve absorption in the digestive tract. This includes common injections such as subcutaneous, intramuscular, and intravenous injections, as well as less common injections such as epidural, intraperitoneal, intraosseous, intracardiac, intraarticular, and intracavernous injections. Common injection sites include the deltoid, vastus lateralis, and ventrogluteal muscles. This allows the medication to be absorbed more rapidly and avoid the first pass effect 201b28e602

The coagulation pathway helps the body stop active bleeds by using vitamin K dependent clotting factors (factors II, VII, IX, and X) which are synthesized by the liver. Vitamin K can be delivered into the body via the oral, subcutaneous, intramuscular, or intravenous routes of administration. 201b28e602

Rho(D) immune globulin Other side effects include allergic Rho(D) immune globulin (RhIG) is a medication used to prevent RhD isoimmunization in mothers who are RhD negative and to treat idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura (ITP) in people who are Rh positive. It may also be used when RhD-negative people are given RhD-positive blood. It is often given both during and following pregnancy. It is given by injection into muscle or a vein. Common side effects include fever, headache, pain at the site of injection, and red blood cell breakdown. A single dose lasts 12 weeks. RhIG is commonly referred to as 'anti-D'. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for the treatment of schizophrenia in December 2006, and in the European Union in June 2007. Paliperidone palmitate is a long-acting injectable formulation of paliperidone palmitoyl ester. It is on the World Health Organization's List of Essential Medicines. Paliperidone is available as a generic medication. 201b28e602 Common side effects include fever, headache, pain at the site of injection, and red blood cell breakdown. Other side effects include allergic reactions, kidney problems, and a very small risk of viral infections. In those with ITP, the amount of red blood cell breakdown may be significant. Use is safe with breastfeeding. Rho(D) immune globulin is made up of antibodies to the antigen Rho(D) present on some red blood cells. Common sites for intramuscular injections include the deltoid muscle of the upper arm and the gluteal muscle of the buttock. In infants, the vastus lateralis muscle of the thigh is commonly used. The injection site must be cleaned before administering the injection, and the injection is then administered in a fast, darting motion to decrease the discomfort to the individual. The volume to be injected in the muscle is usually limited to 2-5 milliliters, depending on injection site. A site with signs of infection

or muscle atrophy should not be chosen.
