Computed tomography of the abdomen and pelvis Renal stones, appendicitis, pancreatitis, diverticulitis, abdominal aortic aneurysm, and bowel obstruction are conditions that are readily diagnosed and assessed with CT. for bowel preparation for CT scan of the abdomen. It is also a useful test to investigate acute abdominal pain (especially of the lower quadrants, whereas ultrasound is the preferred first line investigation for right upper quadrant pain). It is used frequently to determine stage of cancer and to follow progress. Contrast CT Using contrast material can also help to obtain functional information about tissues. CT images are called precontrast or native-phase images before any radiocontrast has been administered, and postcontrast after radiocontrast administration. Often, images are taken both with and without radiocontrast. Contrast CT, or contrast-enhanced computed tomography (CECT), is X-ray computed tomography (CT) using radiocontrast. This is useful to highlight structures such as blood vessels that otherwise would be difficult to delineate from their surroundings. Although it is self-limiting, epiploic appendagitis can cause severe... 3499989d7e Appendicitis is primarily caused by a blockage of the hollow portion in the appendix. This blockage typically results from a faecolith, a calcified "stone" made of feces. Some studies show a correlation between appendicoliths and disease severity. Other factors such as inflamed lymphoid tissue from a viral infection, intestinal parasites, gallstone, or tumors may also lead to this blockage. When the appendix becomes blocked, it experiences increased pressure, reduced blood flow, and bacterial growth, resulting in inflammation. This combination of factors causes tissue injury and, ultimately, tissue death. If this process is left untreated, it can lead to the appendix rupturing, which releases bacteria into the abdominal cavity, potentially leading to severe complications. 3499989d7e == Diagnosis == 3499989d7e IAI can be classified into uncomplicated and complicated infections. Uncomplicated infections often involved the infection of single organ and can be controlled by surgical removal of the source of infection, and antibiotics is not required after the surgery to control the infection. IAI can be diffuse (spread throughout the abdomen) or as localized as an abscess. In complicated infections, the infection can spread to a part or to the whole of the peritoneum, causing peritonitis. 3499989d7e Risk factors for developing liver abscess can be due to infection, post-procedural infection and metastasis such as primary liver tumours, liver metastasis, biliary procedures, biliary injuries, biliary tract disease, appendicitis, and diverticulitis. 3499989d7e

Fecalith It is also called appendicolith when it occurs in the appendix and is sometimes concurrent with appendicitis. It can form secondary to fecal impaction. CT scan Projectional radiography Ultrasound A small fecalith is one cause of both appendicitis and acute diverticulitis. They can also obstruct diverticula. A fecaloma is a more severe form of fecal impaction, and a hardened fecaloma may be considered a giant fecalith. It is a hardening of feces into lumps of varying size and may occur anywhere in the intestinal tract but is typically found in the colon. The multiple X-ray measurements taken from different angles are then processed on a computer using tomographic reconstruction algorithms to produce tomographic (cross-sectional) images (virtual "slices") of a body. The majority of people with a Meckel's diverticulum are asymptomatic. An asymptomatic Meckel's diverticulum is called a silent Meckel's diverticulum. If symptoms do occur, they typically appear before the age of

two years. The most common presenting symptom is painless rectal bleeding such as melaena-like black offensive stools, followed by intestinal obstruction, volvulus and intussusception. Occasionally, Meckel's diverticulitis may present with all the features of acute appendicitis. Also, severe pain in the epigastric region is experienced by the person along with bloating in the epigastric and umbilical regions. At times... 3499989d7e Epiploic appendices are small, fat-filled sacs or finger-like projections along the surface of the upper and lower colon and rectum. They may become acutely inflamed as a result of torsion (twisting) or venous thrombosis. The inflammation causes pain, often described as sharp or stabbing, located on the left, right, or central regions of the abdomen. There is sometimes nausea and vomiting. The symptoms may mimic those of acute appendicitis, diverticulitis, or cholecystitis. The pain is characteristically intense during/after defecation or micturition (espec. in the sigmoid type) due to the effect of traction on the pedicle of the lesion caused by straining and emptying of the bowel and bladder. Initial lab studies are usually normal. Patients will present with a sudden onset of cramps/abdominal pain or a 'stitch'. The pain localises in the area of the umbilicus and can radiate to the lumbar and surrounding regions. 3499989d7e IAI is always caused by an infection, usually a bacterial infection, and it usually results in inflammation of the peritoneum. As a result, IAI is sometimes called peritonitis. However, peritonitis can be caused by non-infectious factors, such as chemical irritation. 3499989d7e

Multidetector CT (MDCT) can clearly delineate anatomic structures in the abdomen, which is critical in the diagnosis of internal diaphragmatic and other nonpalpable or unsuspected hernias. Appendicitis Symptoms commonly include right lower abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, fever and decreased appetite. However, approximately 40% of people do not have these typical symptoms. CT scan is more accurate than ultrasound Appendicitis is inflammation of the appendix. Severe complications of a ruptured appendix include widespread, painful inflammation of the inner lining of the abdominal wall and sepsis. most commonly used imaging tests for diagnosing appendicitis are ultrasound and computed tomography (CT scan) 3499989d7e
