On the morning of October 12, 1968, Chandler and his son planned to visit São Paulo's enormous Ibirapuera Park. Chandler entered his Chevrolet Impala station wagon, backed out of the garage, but stopped as he waited for his son to close the gate, then was blocked by a Volkswagen Beetle from entering the road. As Chandler's wife and one of four children watched, Chandler was ambushed by Diógenes José Carvalho ("Luis"), who unloaded six rounds of his Taurus .38 caliber revolver into Chandler, then Marcos Antonio Braz de Oliveira ("Marquito"), who opened fire on the American veteran with a machine gun. Chandler was riddled with 14 bullets. == Early life and career == Pixinguinha merged the traditional music of 19th-century composers with modern jazz-inspired harmonies, sophisticated arrangements, and Afro-Brazilian rhythms. This is attributed as having helped establish choro as an aspect of Brazilian culture. In 2014, the production of regional editions of the newspaper began. In addition to having a local focus, the regional editions aim to reach the working class. For this reason, they are produced in tabloid format and distributed free of charge in public spaces. Currently, there are regional editions in Rio de Janeiro, São Paulo, Minas Gerais, Paraná, and Pernambuco. The Rio Grande do Sul edition of Brasil de Fato was launched during events in Santa Maria and Porto Alegre. == Life and academic career == == Characteristics and ideology == The Brazilian National Congress has been since characterized by political fragmentation, reaching a peak of 35 registered political parties in 2018, 30 of which were represented in congress after the 2018 general election, with an effective number of parties of 16.5. An electoral threshold introduced in 2017, which restricted access to party subsidies and free party political broadcasts, combined with the end of coalitions in proportional elections, has since caused this number to decrease. Since 2021, parties are allowed to unite under party federations, with a minimum duration of four years, sharing a common statute and leadership. Produced by Guto Graça Mello and Max Pierre, the album As Canções que Você Fez pra Mim by singer Maria Bethânia features the artist singing songs by Roberto Carlos and Erasmo Carlos, considered one of the country's leading songwriting duos.
