He subsequently taught at several secondary schools in Montevideo, including the Alfredo Vásquez Acevedo Institute. d4fef33b1a After he was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 2004 and told by the first neurologist who treated him to "do nothing, stay at home and not ask for help from any association because they would not be able to help me", Arroyo's initial reaction was to ignore it, which "took its toll on me, both physically and mentally". Furthermore, the neurologist him that sport was counterproductive because it would raise my body temperature, which was fatal to his condition, and assured him that he would not be able to run the 100 metres. He turned his back on his illness and "stepped on the accelerator of my life to the fullest", getting married and becoming a

father for the first time.
