As a biological discipline, the scope of parasitology is not determined by the organism or environment in question but by their way of life

There are several complications with the terminology: The study of these diverse organisms means that the subject is often broken up into simpler, more focused units, which use common techniques, even if they are not studying the same organisms or diseases. Much research in parasitology falls somewhere between two or more of these definitions. In general, the study of prokaryotes falls under the field of bacteriology rather than parasitology. == Major health concerns == Side effects may occur from sudden discontinuation and prolonged, continuous use can lead to skin thinning. Giovanni Cosimo Bonomo was born to French pharmacist Stefano Bonomo and his wife Barbara Boccacci on 30 November 1666. He was born in Livorno, a multicultural city at that time. He studied at the University of Pisa, where he received his doctorate in philosophy and medicine on 22 June 1681. On 18 December 1683, he obtained his license to practice as a freelance physician at the Collegio dei Medici degli Speciali of Florence, the modern-day Università degli Studi di Firenze. His auditors included Francesco Redi, who would become his biggest advocate. Weaker topical steroids are utilized for thin-skinned and sensitive areas, especially areas under occlusion, such as the armpit, groin, buttock crease, and breast folds. Poor living conditions in developing regions of tropical countries have led to a rising number of non-communicable diseases as well as the prevalence of neglected tropical diseases. These diseases include cancer and cardiovascular disease, which, in the past, have been more of a worry in developed countries. Giovanni Cosimo Bonomo (30 November 1666 – 13 January 1696) was an Italian physician, known for discovering the itch mite as the cause of the skin disease scabies. By contradicting contemporary medical opinion and the papal aristocracy, he was harshly criticized and had a hard time finding a job. Eventually he became a personal physician for the German Electress Palatine Anna Maria Luisa de' Medici. Excluding designer dogs, mixed-breed dogs are generally considered less financially valuable than purebred dogs. Carlo Musitano was born at Castrovillari, in Calabria, on January 5, 1635. He graduated in theology and philosophy, and was ordained a priest in 1658. He then settled in Naples, where he studied medicine under the guidance of renowned masters such as Tommaso Cornelio, Leonardo da Capua and Sebastiano Bartoli and acquired considerable reputation as a physician. Musitano also practised surgery. His treatise on the theory and practice of surgery appeared in 1698.

Refugee health estimated that up to 40% of people they treated had scabies. The health status of refugee's can be tied to factors such as the person who migrated's geographic origin, conditions of refugee camps or urban settings where they lived, and personal, physical, and psychological conditions of the person, either pre-existing or acquired while traveling from their homeland to a camp or eventually to their new home. People who have been displaced can be affected by infectious diseases or some chronic diseases that are uncommon in the country in which they eventually settle. Mental health is an important consideration and can greatly impact people who are displaced. Health care staff working in camps across Europe reported barriers to scabies control included: Refugee health is the field of study on the health effects experienced by people who have been displaced into another country or even to another part of the world, as a result of unsafe circumstances such as war or persecution.

Neglected tropical diseases Chromoblastomycosis and other deep mycoses, scabies and other ectoparasites, and snakebite envenomation were added to the WHO list in 2017. In sub-Saharan Africa, the effect of neglected tropical diseases as a group is comparable to that of malaria and tuberculosis. These diseases are broadly characterized by neglect within global health policy, contrasted with the "big three" infectious diseases (HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria), which generally receive greater treatment and research funding. NTD co-infection can also make HIV/AIDS and tuberculosis more deadly. They are caused by a variety of pathogens, such as viruses, bacteria, protozoa, and parasitic worms (helminths) and mites (acarines). These diseases are Neglected tropical diseases (NTDs)

are a diverse group of tropical infections that are common in low-income populations in developing regions of Africa, Asia, and the Americas 6b73a8910f

Some treatments for NTDs are relatively inexpensive. For example, praziquantel for schistosomiasis costs about US \$0.20 per child per year. Nevertheless, in 2010 it was estimated that control of neglected diseases would require funding of between US\$2 billion and \$3 billion over the subsequent five to seven years.
