Human feces have similarities to the feces of other animals and varies significantly in appearance (i.e. size, color, texture), according to the state of the diet, digestive system, and general health. Normally, human feces are semisolid, with a mucus coating. Small pieces of harder, less moist feces can sometimes be seen impacted in the distal (final or lower) end. This is a normal occurrence when a prior bowel movement is incomplete, and feces are returned from the rectum to the large intestine, where water is further absorbed.

It should not be used for people with diarrhea caused by an infection, for example with *Clostridioides difficile* infection, since the slowing of peristalsis can prevent clearing of the infectious organism.

Liver abscesses can occur without previous diarrhea. Diagnosis is made by stool examination using microscopy, but it can be difficult to distinguish *E. histolytica* from other harmless *Entamoeba* species. An increased white blood cell count may be present in severe cases. The most accurate test is finding specific antibodies in the blood, though the antibody test may remain positive following...

Diphenoxylate It should not be given to children due to the risk that they will stop breathing and should not be used in people with *Clostridioides difficile* infection. Diphenoxylate is a centrally active opioid drug of the phenylpiperidine series that is used as a combination drug with atropine for the treatment of diarrhea. stop the formation of loose and liquid stools; the atropine is an anticholinergic and is present to prevent drug abuse and overdose. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends exclusively feeding an infant breast milk for the first six months of life and continuing for one year or longer as desired by infant and mother, and states that formula is an "acceptable substitute". During prehistoric times, breastfeeding infants was the only option for nutrition, such that the young would perish otherwise. Breastfeeding is rarely contraindicated, but is not recommended for mothers being treated for cancer, those with active tuberculosis, HIV, substance abuse, or leukemia. Based on reviews of epidemiologic data and literature, some researchers believe that the risks have been over-stated and are poorly understood by the public. Cases generally resolve spontaneously, with or without treatment, and the cause is typically unknown. One survey found that long-distance Appalachian Trail hikers reported diarrhea as their most common illness. Potential sources are contaminated food or water, or "hand-to-mouth", directly from another person who is infected. Clear, disinfected water or other liquids are routinely recommended. More limited, separate studies have presented highly varied estimated rates of affliction that range from 3 percent to 74 percent of wilderness visitors 3bc73b17af

One technique is known as "streaking". In this technique, a drop of the culture on the end of a thin, sterile loop of wire, sometimes known as an inoculator, is streaked across the surface of the agar leaving organisms behind, a higher number at the beginning of the streak and a lower number at the end.
