Ordinarily, the body responds to reduced energy intake by firstly exhausting the contents of the digestive tract along with glycogen reserves present in both muscle and liver cells through glycogenolysis. After prolonged periods of starvation, this store of glycogen runs out, and the body then starts burning fat reserves and consuming muscle and other tissues. Stearoyl-CoA 9-desaturase the synthesis of various kinds of lipids, including phospholipids, triglycerides, and can also be used as mediators in signal transduction and differentiation Stearoyl-CoA desaturase (Δ -9-desaturase or SCD-1) is an endoplasmic reticulum enzyme that catalyzes the rate-limiting step in the formation of monounsaturated fatty acids (MUFAs), specifically oleate and palmitoleate from stearoyl-CoA and palmitoyl-CoA. In humans, the enzyme is present in two isoforms, encoded respectively by the SCD1 and SCD5 genes. Oleate and palmitoleate are major components of membrane phospholipids, cholesterol esters and alkyl-diacylglycerol 4c6e7a5b94

There are many treatments, both surgical and conservative. About 2-3% of all fluid collections surrounding the lungs

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(pleural effusions) are chylothoraces. It is important to distinguish a chylothorax from a pseudochylothorax (a pleural effusion that happens to be high in cholesterol), which has a similar appearance visually but is caused by more chronic inflammatory processes and requires a different treatment. 4c6e7a5b94 == History == 4c6e7a5b94

Epinephrine Starvation response in animals (including humans) is a set of adaptive biochemical and physiological changes, triggered by lack of food or extreme weight loss, in which the body seeks to conserve energy by reducing metabolic rate and/or non-resting energy expenditure to prolong survival and preserve body fat and lean mass. Headquartered at the Department of Clinical Biochemistry at Herlev Hospital, it was established in 2003 with professor Børge Nordestgaard as principal investigator, and it is the world's largest population study that follows the long-term health development of a healthy population over time, currently collecting data on over 170,000 enrolled participants. Chylothorax If normal thoracic duct drainage is disrupted, either due to obstruction or rupture, chyle can leak and accumulate within the negative-pressured pleural space. The lymphatic vessels of the digestive system normally return lipids absorbed from the small bowel via the thoracic duct, which ascends behind the esophagus to drain into the left brachiocephalic vein. Since chyle is rich in triglycerides, a pleural effusion that is rich in triglycerides (>110 mg/dL) confirms the presence of a chylothorax; A chylothorax is an abnormal accumulation of chyle, a type of lipid-rich lymph, in the pleural space surrounding the lung.

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In people on a normal diet, this fluid collection can sometimes be identified by its turbid, milky white appearance, since chyle contains emulsified triglycerides. from consideration 4c6e7a5b94

Lipoproteins transfer lipids (fats) around the body in the extracellular fluid, making fats available to body cells for receptor-mediated endocytosis. Lipoproteins are complex particles composed of multiple proteins, typically 80–100 proteins per particle (organized by a single apolipoprotein B for LDL and the larger particles). A single LDL particle is about 22–27.5 nanometers in diameter, typically transporting 3,000 to 6,000 fat molecules per particle and varying in size according to the number and mix of fat molecules contained within. The lipids carried include all fat molecules with cholesterol, phospholipids, and triglycerides dominant; amounts of each vary considerably. 4c6e7a5b94 Fat bloom is the result of gradual separation of the cocoa butter and the dissolved components of the chocolate mixture. Generally bloom arises due to storage or age. Improper formulation exacerbates the problem. == In humans == 4c6e7a5b94 Stearoyl-CoA desaturase is a key enzyme in fatty acid metabolism. It is responsible for forming a double bond in stearoyl-CoA. This is how the monounsaturated fatty acid oleic acid is produced from the saturated fatty acid, stearic acid. A series of redox reactions, during which two electrons flow from NADH to flavoprotein cytochrome b5, then to the electron acceptor cytochrome b5 as well as molecular oxygen introduces a single double bond within a row of methylene fatty acyl-CoA substrates. The complexed enzyme adds a single double bond between the C9 and C10 of long-chain acyl-CoAs from de-novo synthesis. 4c6e7a5b94

Hepatic hydrothorax Although it is most common in people with severe ascites, it can also occur in people with mild or no ascites. It is found in 5–10% of people with liver cirrhosis and 2–3% of people with pleural

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effusions. cirrhosis. In cases of decompensated liver cirrhosis, prevalence rises significantly up to 90%. Additionally, the fluid in chylothorax is much higher in triglycerides, and has a milky appearance. Over 85% of cases occurring on the right, 13% on the left, and 2% on both. It is defined as an effusion of over 500 mL in people with liver cirrhosis that is not caused by heart, lung, or pleural disease. Symptoms are not specific and mostly involve the respiratory system. Another, more serious differential diagnosis Hepatic hydrothorax is a rare form of pleural effusion that occurs in people with liver cirrhosis 4c6e7a5b94

Chocolate bloom arises due to storage or age. The fats in cocoa butter are a mixture of triglycerides with varying melting Chocolate bloom is either of two types of whitish coating that can appear on the surface of chocolate: fat bloom, caused by changes in the fat crystals in the chocolate; and sugar bloom, due to crystals formed by the action of moisture on the sugar. Improper formulation exacerbates the problem. Chocolate that has "bloomed" is still safe to eat (as it is a non-perishable food due to its sugar content), but may have an unappetizing appearance and surface texture. Chocolate bloom can be repaired by melting the chocolate down, stirring it, then pouring it into a mould and allowing it to cool and re-solidify, bringing the sugar or fat back into the solution. Fat and sugar bloom damage the appearance of chocolate but do not limit its shelf life 4c6e7a5b94

The name "fructose" was coined in 1857 by the English chemist William Allen Miller. Hyponatremia Correcting hyponatremia too quickly can lead to complications. Treatment is based on the underlying cause. It is generally defined as a sodium concentration of less than 135 mmol/L (135 mEq/L), with severe hyponatremia being below 120 mEq/L. Mild symptoms include a decreased ability to think, headaches, nausea, and poor balance. Rapid partial correction with 3% normal saline is Hyponatremia or hyponatraemia is a low concentration of sodium in the blood. Severe symptoms include confusion, seizures, and coma; death can ensue. Symptoms can be absent, mild or severe 4c6e7a5b94

The causes of hyponatremia are typically classified by a person's body fluid status into low volume, normal volume, or high volume. Low volume hyponatremia can occur from diarrhea, vomiting, diuretics, and sweating. Normal volume hyponatremia is divided into cases with dilute urine and concentrated urine. Cases in which the urine is dilute include adrenal insufficiency, hypothyroidism, and drinking too much water or too much beer. Cases in which the urine is concentrated include syndrome of inappropriate antidiuretic hormone secretion (SIADH). High volume hyponatremia can occur from heart failure, liver failure, and kidney failure. Conditions that can lead to falsely low sodium measurements include high blood protein levels such as in multiple myeloma, high blood fat levels, and... 4c6e7a5b94 The condition is diagnosed based on the existence of liver cirrhosis and fluid build-up in the abdomen (ascites) and analysis of the fluid. The fluid has a low protein content. Mainly, the condition is treated by medical management, such as diet adjustment and usage of diuretics. When the condition does not respond, it is known as refractory hepatic hydrothorax: treatment includes inserting a transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic

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shunt (TIPS). The only curative treatment is a liver transplant. The prognosis is usually unfavorable...
