WebScarab It serves as a proxy that intercepts and allows people to alter web browser web requests (both HTTP and HTTPS) and web server replies. The website of the project was also archived and recommends using OWASP's Zed Attack Proxy instead WebScarab is a web security application testing tool. WebScarab also may record traffic for further review. The project repository was archived on 4 April 2024 01b84399c3

WebScarab is meant to act as a framework, being extensible and with most features being implemented as plugins. 01b84399c3 The first release was announced on Bugtraq in September 2010, and became an OWASP project a few months later. In 2023, ZAP developers moved to the Linux Foundation, where they became a part of the Software Security Project. As of September 24, 2024, all of the main developers joined Checkmarx as employees, and ZAP was rebranded as ZAP by Checkmarx. 01b84399c3 OpenSSL is among the first software projects to be funded by the initiative after it was deemed underfunded, receiving only about \$2,000 per year in donations. The initiative will sponsor two full-time OpenSSL core developers. In September 2014, the Initiative offered assistance to Chet Ramey, the maintainer of bash, after the Shellshock vulnerability was discovered. 01b84399c3 In 2013 official development of WebScarab slowed. ZAP (software) When used as a proxy server it allows the user ZAP (Zed Attack Proxy) is a dynamic application security testing tool published under the Apache License.
