Push–pull agricultural pest management For example, cereal crops like maize or sorghum are often infested by stem borers. Grasses planted around the perimeter of the crop attract and trap the pests, whereas other plants, like Desmodium, planted between the rows of maize, repel the pests and control the parasitic plant Striga. and national partners. Economic study has calculated the return on investment of push-pull methods for farmers Push–pull technology is an intercropping strategy for controlling agricultural pests by using repellent "push" plants and trap "pull" plants. Push–pull technology was developed at the International Centre of Insect Physiology and Ecology (ICIPE) in Kenya in collaboration with Rothamsted Research, UK. This technology has been taught to smallholder farmers through collaborations with universities,

Pull-to-refresh Steps involved in the original version of pull-to-refresh as released Pull-to-refresh is a touchscreen gesture developed by Loren Brichter. Brichter currently does not have any plans to continue work on pull-to-refresh. It consists of touching the screen of a computing device with a finger or pressing a button on a pointing device, dragging the screen

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downward with the finger or pointing device, and then releasing it, as a signal to the application to refresh the contents of the screen. Other names for the gesture include "pull-down-to-refresh", "pull-to-reload", "swipe to refresh", "scroll to refresh", and variations thereof f799816d8e

The Feldenkrais Method is a type of alternative movement therapy that proponents claim can repair impaired connections between the motor cortex and the body, so benefiting the quality of body movement and improving wellbeing.
