In both tests, a positive sign is indicated by numbness, tingling or pain in the thumb, index and half of the middle finger. 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hemostasis, cancer therapy, and ultrasound assisted thrombolysis. Ultrasound used for therapeutic benefit often uses focused ultrasound waves, however, unfocused ultrasound waves may also be used. Physiotherapeutic ultrasound was introduced into clinical practice in the 1950s, with lithotripsy introduced in the 1980s. In the research field, use of ultrasound is being explored. Therapeutic ultrasound refers generally to the use of ultrasound for the treatment of a medical condition or for therapeutic benefit.
