Food addiction Those with eating addictions often overconsume such foods despite the adverse consequences (such as excess weight gain, diabetes, and heart disease) associated with their overconsumption. Such foods often have high sugar, fat, and salt contents (HFSS), and markedly activate the reward system in humans and other animals. through binge eating experiences feelings of guilt after their binges, that person can be said to have binge eating disorder (BED). == Signs and symptoms == Early life Emotional eating includes eating in response to any emotion, whether that be positive or negative. Most frequently, people refer to emotional eating as "eating to cope with negative emotions." In these situations, emotional eating can be considered a form of disordered eating, which is defined as "an increase in food intake in response to negative emotions" and can be considered a maladaptive strategy. More specifically, emotional eating in order to relieve negative emotions would qualify as a form of emotion-focused coping, which attempts to minimize, regulate, and prevent emotional distress. Recent meta-analysis suggest that the prevalence of negative emotional eating in middle-aged adults is approximately 16%.One study found that emotional eating sometimes does not reduce emotional... Diagnosis is based on a person's medical

history; however, this is difficult, as people are usually secretive about their binge eating and purging habits. Further, the diagnosis of anorexia nervosa takes precedence over that of bulimia. Eating disorder These disorders do not include obesity. Types of eating disorders include anorexia, where the person has an intense fear of gaining weight, thus restricts food and/or over exercises to manage this fear; bulimia, where individuals eat a large quantity (binging) then try to rid themselves of the food (purging), in an attempt to not gain any weight; binge

The YouTube channel was created by Rea as Binging with Babish on August 21, 2006; his name was inspired by The West Wing character Oliver Babish.
